- Boral pavers are designed to suit a range of applications around the home including walkways, patios, courtyards, pool surrounds and driveways.
- Ideal for pool areas, Boral's range of wetcast pavers are available with a matching bullnose to create visually enticing pool surrounds.
- Designed for driveways, the Boral range of small format pavers feature a thickness of greater than 50mm to accommodate household vehicles.*
- Using individual segmental pavers can add character and interest to pathways, patios and courtyards with different laying patterns.

- Boral pavers come in a carefully selected number of colours and textures supported by years of product development.
- Boral pavers are available in a range of shapes and sizes including cobblestone, bullnose, flagstone, standard and large format units.
- Individual pavers allow patterns to be created with ease unlike stencil concrete, concrete and asphalt alternatives.

EASY INSTALLATION

- Unlike thinner pavers such as some natural stone, Boral pavers are thick enough to be laid directly on to crushed rock (road base) and sand, removing the need for a concrete base saving time and reducing costs.
- Pavers can be installed over existing concrete paths and driveways.
- Paving can be re-worked unlike stencil concrete, concrete and asphalt which can only be reworked for a short period of time before it sets and becomes waste.
- Pavers offer flexible installation options. DIY enthusiasts can install the pavers themselves by following Boral's Installation Guides, or alternatively a professional can also be hired.
- For convenience, pavers can be delivered to site in advance of building works.
- Pave around fixtures with ease and should services or pipes need to be accessed, individual pavers may be removed.

LOW MAINTENANCE

- Following installation, pavers should be sealed to help protect against damage. Once sealed, Boral pavers require little maintenance. Please refer to Boral's Caring for Concrete Pavers Guide for more information.

- Boral have developed the Hydrapave® permeable paving system which is a cost-competitive and environmentally productive approach to water run-off. The patented Hydrapave® system allows rain water to infiltrate through small channels formed on the end and sides of the concrete pavers, passing into a prepared sub-base. The water is then detained, filter treated and dispersed, discharged or directed for re-use.
- Pavers can be pulled up, stored, relocated and reinstalled unlike stencil concrete, concrete or asphalt alternatives.
- Pavers can be recycled.
