- 5. In Table 2 in condition C6 replace the night time hours of "(10pm-12am)" with "(10pm-6am)".
- 6. Insert a new condition C7A immediately after Condition C7 as follows:
 - C7A. Within three months of the commencement of extended operation hours as approved under Modification 2, the Applicant must prepare and submit a noise verification report for the development. The noise verification report must:
 - (a) be prepared to the satisfaction of the Planning Secretary;
 - (b) demonstrate that noise verification has been carried out by a suitably qualified and experienced acoustic consultant in accordance with:
 - (i) the Australian Standard AS 1055:2018 Acoustics Description and measurement of environmental noise (Standards Australia, 2018); and
 - the monitoring and reporting requirements detailed in Section 7 of the Noise Policy for Industry (EPA, 2017);
 - (c) include:
 - (i) an analysis of compliance with noise limits specified in condition C6;
 - (ii) an outline of management actions to be taken to address any exceedances of the limits specified in condition C6; and
 - (iii) a description of contingency measures in the event management actions are not effective in reducing noise levels to an acceptable level.

- 7. In condition C53(g), following the word 'direction;', delete the word 'and'.
- 8. In condition C53(h), delete the full stop and replace with a semicolon.
- 9. Insert two new conditions C53(i) and C53(j) immediately after condition C53(h) as follows:
 - (i) vehicle movements entering and leaving the site do not exceed 50 (25 in 25 out) between the hours of 12am and 6am; and
 - (j) heavy vehicles do not use Gipps Road or Victoria Street east when traveling to or from the site between the hours of 12am and 6am.
