We've been extremely busy during April and May introducing our Marulan South operations to a number of interested groups.

Early in May, students from Goulburn, Mulwaree and Trinity High Schools experienced the Peppertree Quarry and Marulan South Limestone site and talked to a number of operators and staff.

The emphasis of the visit was on the work roles available in our industry and the skills and training needed.

The aim was very much to show there are a lot of roles which work together to operate the sites, and a number of ways to get into the industry and each different role.

Meetings are now being arranged with the schools' Careers Advisors as to how we can provide work experience in line with each school's and TAFE's courses.
