CVA Koala survey

Boral continues our partnership with Conservation Volunteers Australia and this year we have been working with the National Parks and Wildlife service at Bungonia to develop a program for community volunteers to assist in koala surveys.



For our local school communities, we are arranging a number of outdoor classroom sessions, on the 23rd and 24th October 2019, at the National Park to learn more about our local endangered species including the Koala. F

For the adult volunteers we will be undertaking evening spotlight surveys to collect useful information on koalas. These are planned for the evenings of the 23, 24, 25 and 26th October 2019. A call out for Volunteers will happen in the next few weeks once the details are finalised.

CCAA Awards
