## Operations review





# Operations

- > In 2021 Hall Quarry Produced approximately 333,000t and Sold 331,000t. Sales has remained consistent through the year despite the effects of COVID19.
- > Sales included concrete aggregates to both Boral and Elvins concrete plants. Road base to jobs such as the Murrumbateman subdivision, Nanima Rd road widening, Gundaroo road work and Yass industrial park.
- > Hall Quarry has had a strong focus on dust and the exposure on our workforce in the past 12 months. This has seen an increase in dust suppression, covering of material transfer points and improved cleaning facilities. This will continue to be a big focus moving forward.
- > No major safety incidence have occurred onsite
- > The quarry has fired 9 blasts in 2021 – please let us know if you would like to be added/removed from the blasting notification list.
- > The fixed plant will be looking at an electrical upgrade in 2022.
- > Hall Quarry has moved to being a smoking free workspace as of the 1st July 2021



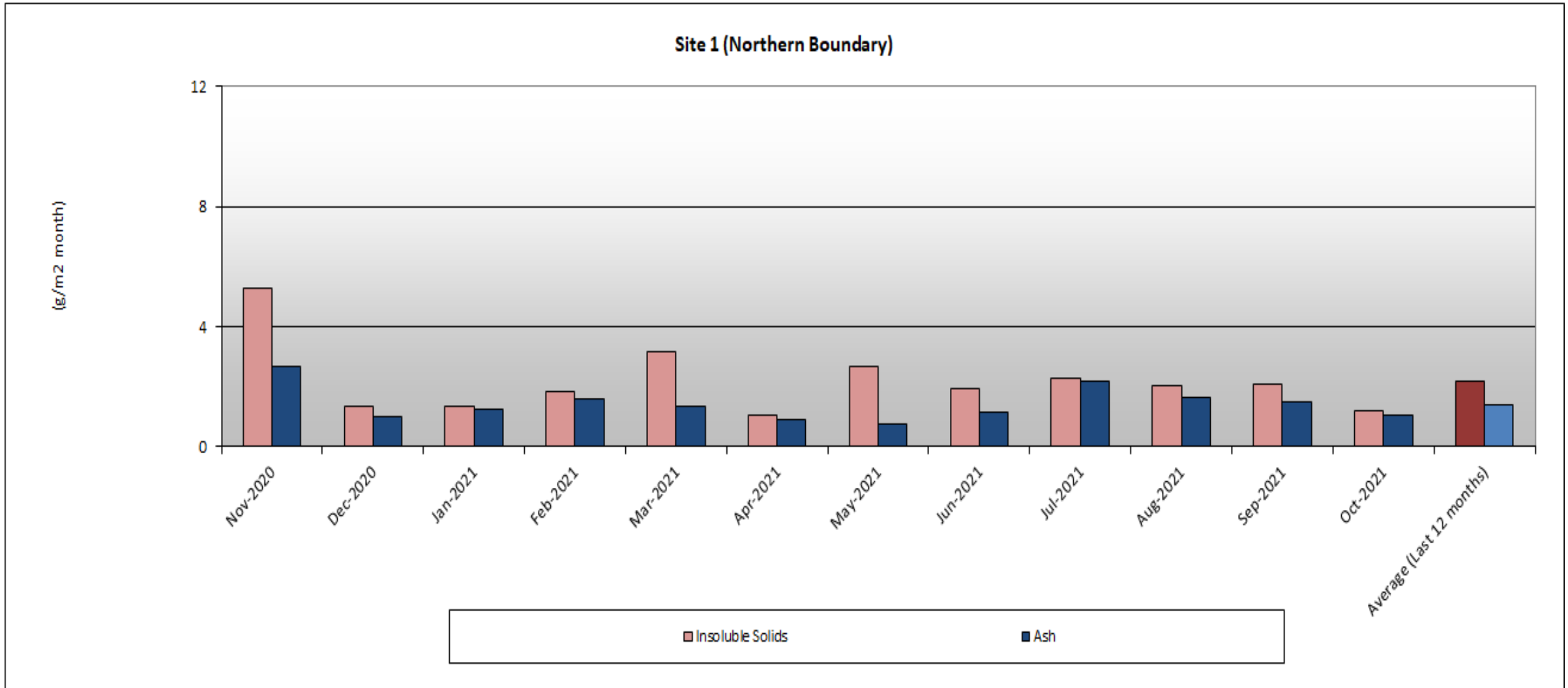

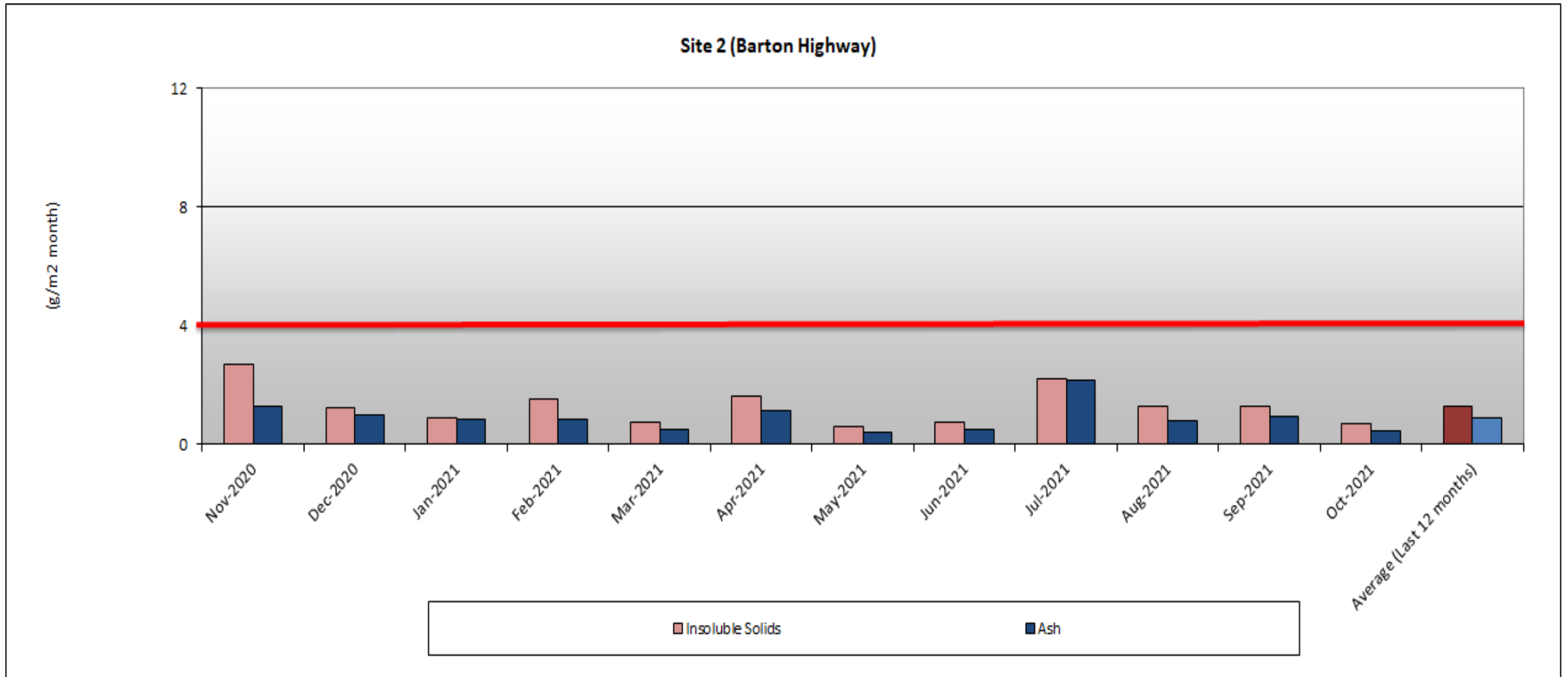


# Environmental monitoring- Deposited Dust Results



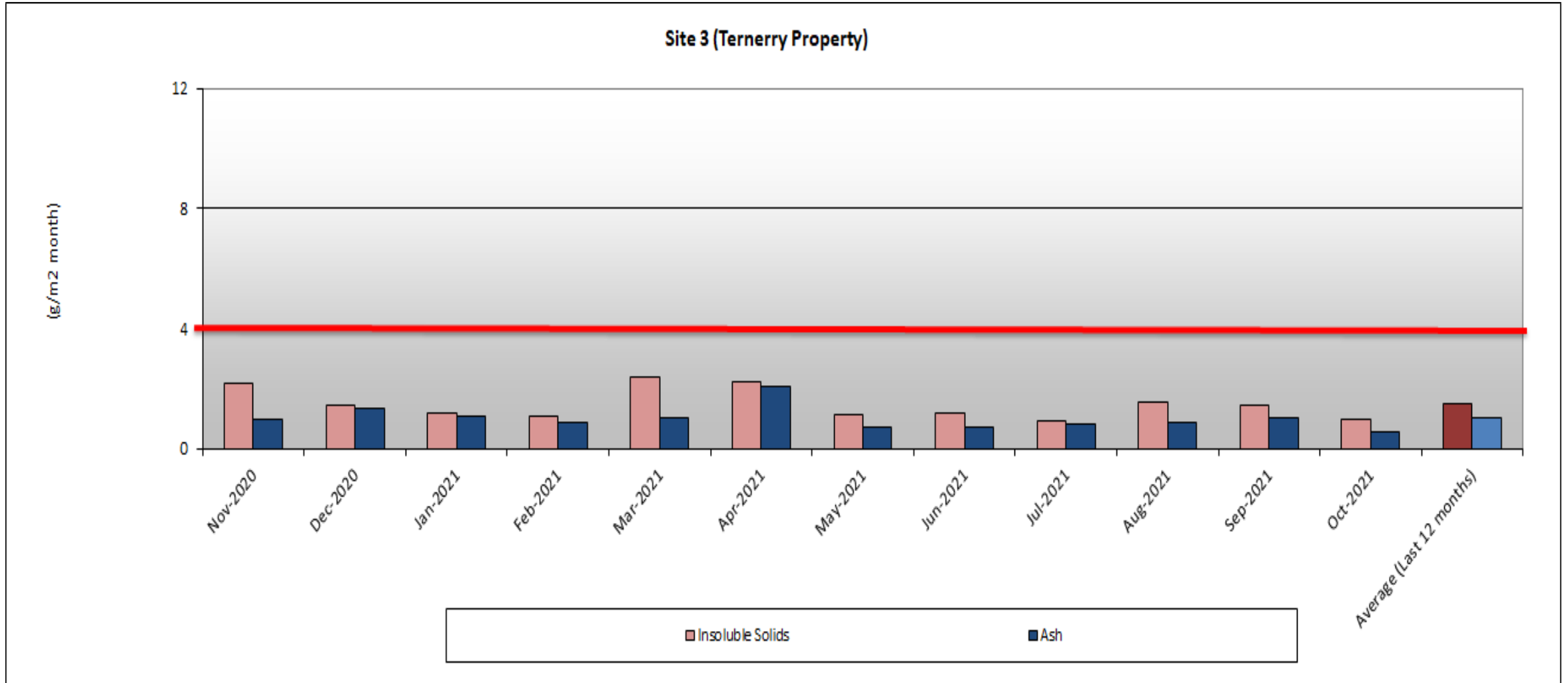

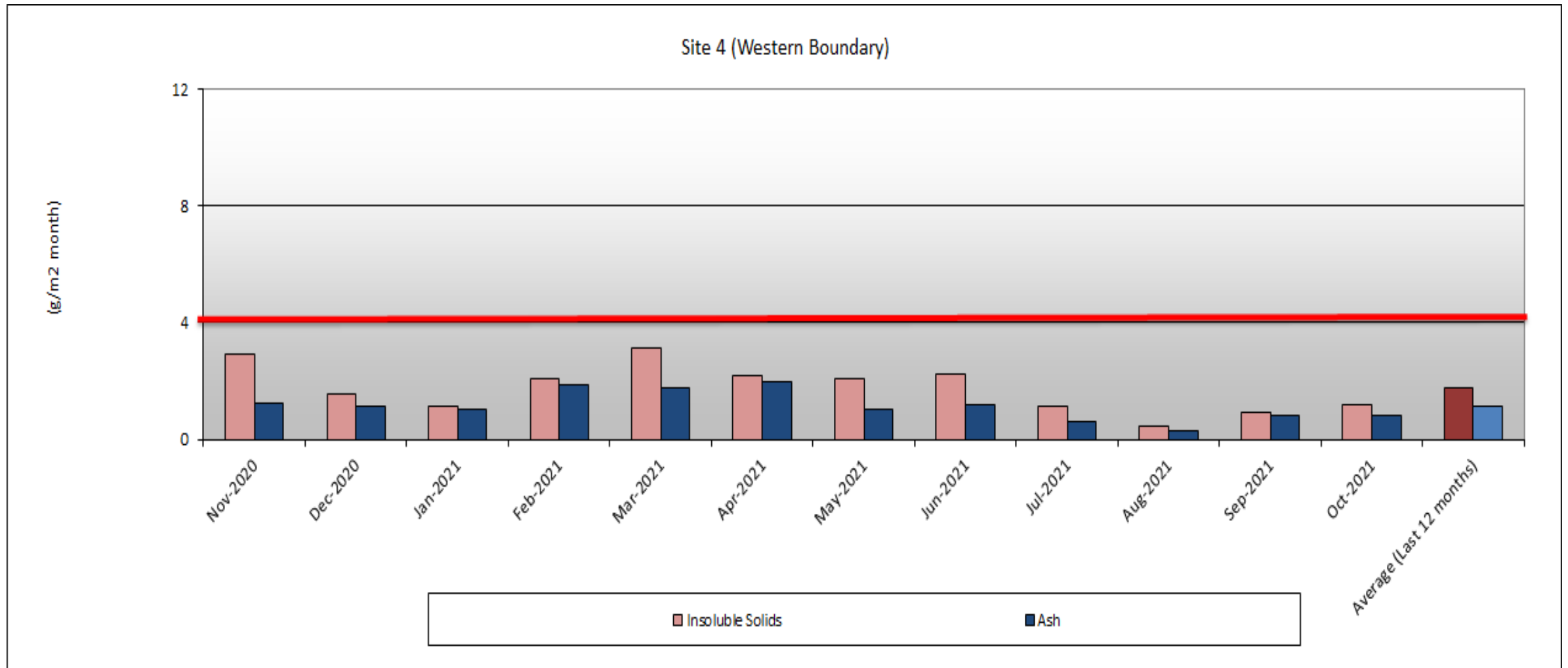


# Environmental monitoring- Deposited Dust Results



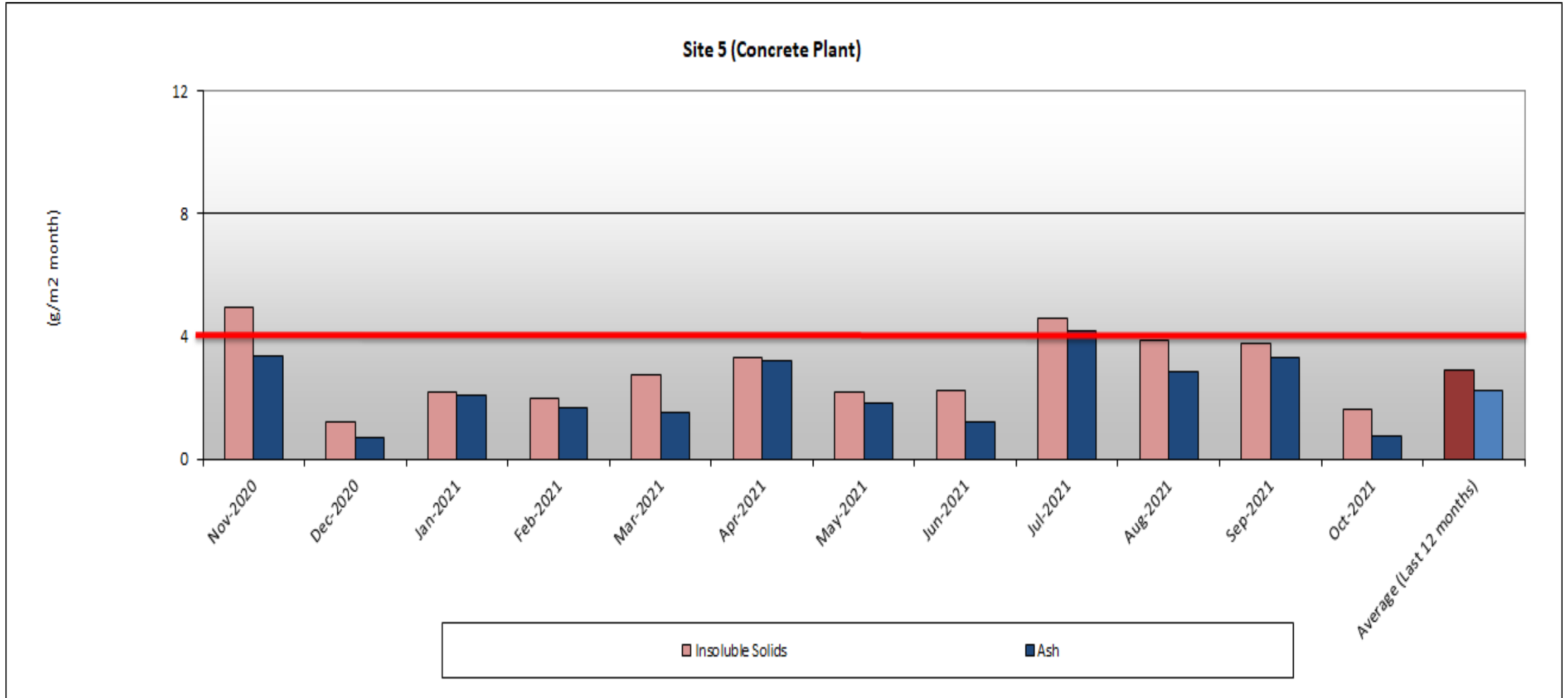

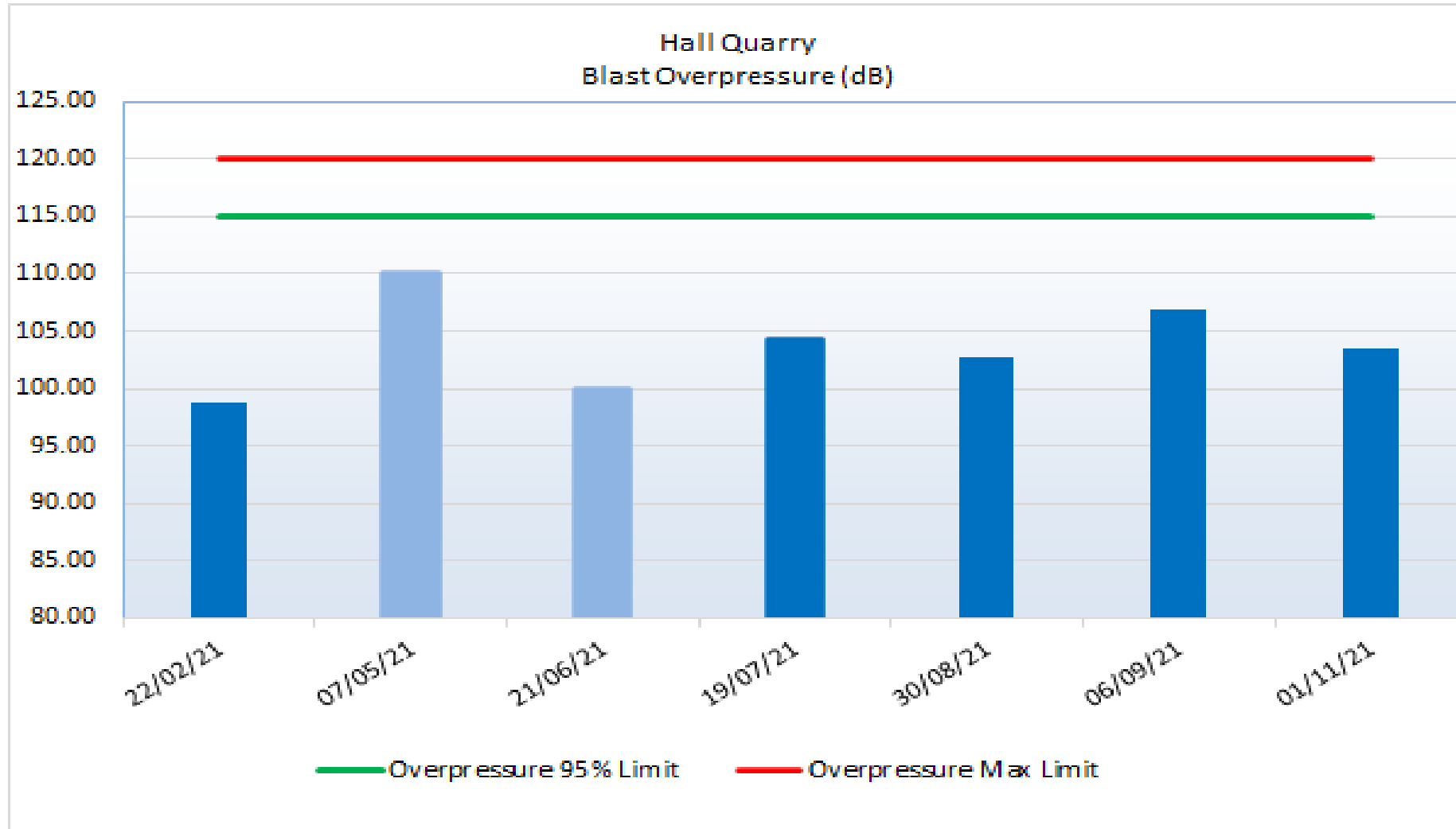

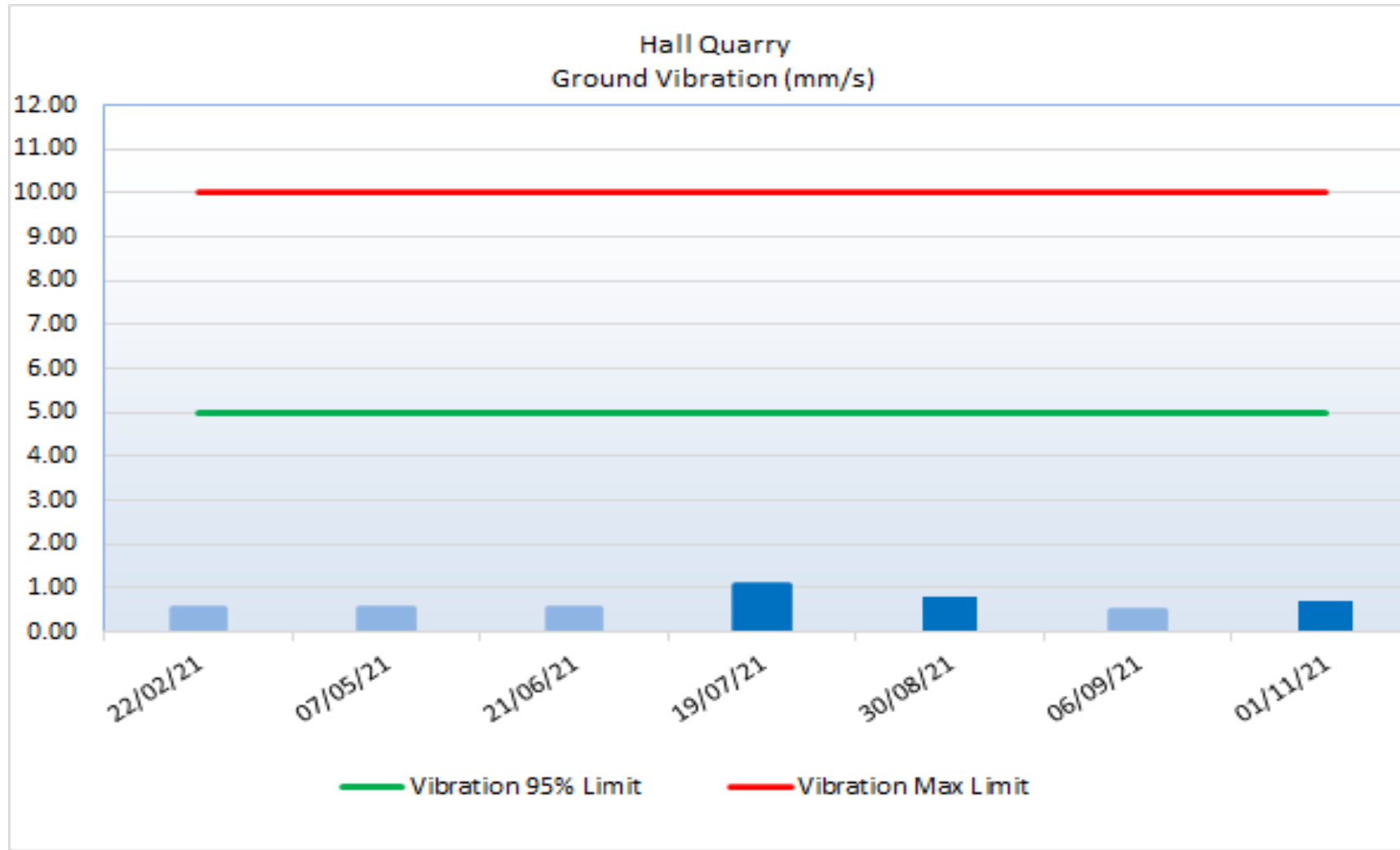


# Environmental monitoring – Blast Overpressure
