Boral Linwood Quarry entrance road relocation project – Works commence on Department of Infrastructure and Transport intersection

As you may know, work on Boral's Linwood Quarry entrance road relocation project commenced on Friday 29 January when the Premier of South Australia, the Honourable Steven Marshall and the Minister for Environment and Water, the Honourable David Speirs officially 'turned the sod' onsite.

In February this year, Boral's civil construction contractor, *Lucas Total Contract Solutions* started to mobilise both equipment and people onsite to enable the road building to start! Now we are in April, we are well and truly on our way with this exciting and much-anticipated project!

Work on the new signalised intersection at the junction of Ocean Boulevard and Majors Road will be **commencing later this week**. This intersection is an essential element of this project as it will enable traffic from the Linwood Quarry to be diverted away from Brighton Road.

While work is continuing along this segment of the project, we would humbly ask for your help to keep our onsite team and other road users safe. Please observe any changes to the local roads while construction is underway. Drive to the conditions in the interests of all road users. Lane closures and speed limit reductions may be necessary to ensure the safety of everyone.
