	<p><b>WORKSHOP/BRAINSTORMING IDEAS SESSION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>What would our stakeholders/residents like to know or see to enable a good understanding of the site and its future?</b></li> </ul> <p>Comments from the Working Group:</p> <p><i>Operational Activities:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <i>Will vegetation be in place prior to expanding to the East? What is the expected growth rate of the proposed vegetation?</i></li> <li>○ <i>Native flora to Hallett Cove. The residents would prefer native species.</i></li> <li>○ <i>Share visual concepts of Eastern development design with Residents.</i></li> </ul> <p><i>Visual:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <i>No solid fence, but would prefer trees and vegetation.</i></li> <li>○ <i>Suggest shrubs could be planted along the southern fence line.</i></li> <li>○ <i>Eastern Quarry faces are to be hidden as best as possible with dense shrub to minimise visual impacts from Perry Barr Road.</i></li> </ul> <p><i>Drill and Blast:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <i>Flexibility on blasting with consideration of weather conditions (to reduce dust and vibrations produced).</i></li> </ul> <p><i>Traffic/Transport:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <i>Vegetation to minimise visual impacts and noise.</i></li> <li>○ <i>Consideration to be given to vegetation height.</i></li> <li>○ <i>Dedicated turning lane for vehicle entering/exiting Ocean Boulevard/Majors Road.</i></li> <li>○ <i>Gradual gradation of new road to minimise noise from the road and trucks.</i></li> </ul> <p><i>Consultation:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ <i>Informal consultation will continue to occur and will be ongoing.</i></li> <li>○ <i>If possible, at a venue either at or near the site for visual references when issues are discussed.</i></li> <li>○ <i>This information is to be put on a website for everyone to access to ensure everyone is able to be informed if they wish.</i></li> <li>○ <i>Consider other avenues to improve communication e.g. local messenger, Marino Residents webpage/Facebook.</i></li> </ul>
