Overburden


Overburden stripping has been progressing at a steady 375,000t/month.

People


Total of 99 employees on site. Production operator celebrated 10year anniversary. One new full time mechanical fitter and a 4th year apprentice welder made permanent






Environmental Incidents Jan 2017 to August 2023












Air – Dust deposition Gauge D1

Peppertree Quarry Deposited Dust 2017 - 2023 Onsite (NW boundary)






Annual Average goal of 4gm2/month

Air – Dust Deposition Gauge D2



Air – Dust Deposition gauge D3






Annual Average goal of 4gm2/month

Air – PM10 annual average






Annual Average goal of 25 ug/m3

Air – PM10 24 Hour performance






24 hour goal of 50ug/m3

Air – Total Suspended Particulates






Annual Average goal of 90ug/m3

Noise – quarterly monitoring




Monitoring was undertaken over 7th and 8th June 2023





Surface water - pH



Surface water - Turbidity






Below guideline for Feb samples

Surface water – Total dissolved solids






Below guideline for Feb samples with exception of Marulan South Creek

Surface water – total Phosphorus






- Monitoring conducted in June.

Ecology



Three year plan developed for ongoing rehabilitation and maintenance

- 16.5ha of tree planting in spring-delayed to autumn due to weather
- 5km of direct seeding in spring- delayed to autumn due to weather
- 4Ha Hydromulching of SOE planned for spring

Weed management undertaken in the last couple of months. Focus on black berry.

More feral goats have been removed, happening on a as needs basis. Ongoing pest monitoring.








Air – Dust deposition Site 1





Air – Dust deposition Site 2








Surface water - pH






Surface water – Total Suspended Solids






Surface water – Nitrogen






Surface water – Phosphorus














New Weather Station Location


- First round of Aboriginal Artefact Collection completed

Work ongoing to replace some of the ageing process infrastructure. Overburden from the North-East and West of pit continues to be placed in the South and Western overburden emplacements.


Pit Update
