Boral's Marulan South Operations are pleased to present our regular newsletter for the information of our valued neighbours and wider community.

Continuing a century-old tradition

As we mentioned in the May edition of our newsletter, we're currently preparing two development applications designed to better position Boral Marulan South Limestone and the Boral Peppertree Quarry for the long term.

The first application is designed to allow the Limestone site to continue its current activities into the next 30 years. It seeks approval for an annual production limit of 3.5 million tonnes of limestone and the establishment of new 'overburden' emplacements around the site.

It also raises the re-routing of Marulan South Road at the Boral end around the proposed emplacement footprints.

Given the road is used by neighbours, other businesses and, if approved, by heavy vehicles moving up to 600 000 tonnes of Boral materials each year, the application also proposes negotiation with Goulburn Mulwaree Council re upgrade and maintenance contributions.

The second process involves modifying the current approval for the Peppertree Quarry so an additional six hours of 'in pit' activity is allowed as part of the 24-hour site operations.

Additional overburden emplacement space for the quarry is also sought as part of the modification.

On 22 July, we held a community planning workshop at the Limestone administration offices which attracted around 20 local community members. Those attending were offered an overview of our proposals and the opportunity to speak with a number of technical experts who are assisting Boral with the applications.

A range of feedback was received from the locals who attended which we are now analysing further as part of the development of the applications. Valuable comments were received about the current condition of Marulan South Road and the establishment of the proposed overburden emplacements which are being carefully considered.

We'd like to offer our thanks to those who gave their time in attending our workshop. If you were unable to attend, don't worry – we are at the start of this process and there will be more opportunities to have your say.
