Meeting started: 5.00pm

1. Apologies:

See above. Apologies were read out.

2. Action Items

- Clayton Hill gave an update on the progress of the Quarry Extension proposal - see heading 3. below.
- Luke Holley gave an update on the Fire Management Plan for the Petrie Quarry - see heading 4. below.
- Wanda Grabowski will provide feedback on the fire management plan at the next meeting.
- Wayne Hardy provided copies of the SEQ Water Fire Management Plan to the liaison group members for their review and comment.
- Andy Stuart will report on the key to the gate on Adsett's Road at the next meeting.
- Elke Stapf passed around an old photograph of the Boral concrete plant (Bowen Hills).

3. Quarry Extension Proposal

Update on IDAS Process: We are awaiting Council decision on the approval. Cr Graeme Ashworth announced DA will go before the strategic committee tomorrow (20 September 07), and if all goes well the decision can be expected as early as 2 October 07.

4. Fire Management Plan:

Luke Holley passed on a copy of the Final Draft Fire Management Plan for the quarry site to the liaison group members for their final review and comment. Comment was requested within 6 weeks so it can be finalised for the next meeting.

5. Current Local Issues

- Steven Wighton reported oil residue on Adsett's Road, where Boral trucks park during waiting periods. Bruce Barry to investigate.
- Wanda Grabowski enquired about the soil quality and tree health of the Koala Fodder plantation. Wanda explained Australia Zoo rejected some of the leaf because of lack of quality. Luke noted this was the first time Boral had received correspondence regarding the matter. He requested such information to be communicated on a regular basis. Elke Stapf reported despite the drought conditions, the trees look healthy. Clayton Hill said that Boral would look into a trial with Australian Bio-Active Compost Tea to determine if the tea can provide a benefit to the plantation without compromising the taste of the leaf for koalas. If successful, the tea may be used when the plantation is established in the Powerlink easement.
- Cr Graeme Ashworth, PRSC, gave an update on the Council amalgamation: on 15 March 08, new amalgamated Moreton Bay Regional Council will take over. With the new internal boundaries, there will be 12 Councillors for the new Regional Council. The old Pine Shire will have six of those Councillors in their area (down from 10 Councillors). Petrie Quarry should be in the new Division 11.

6. Current Operational Issues

- Business as usual, nothing to report.

7. Any other business

Boral supplied rock, aggregate and sand samples, which will be included in the "Supplying the Building Trade" permanent display at the Pine Rivers Heritage Museum, Kurwongbah (Petrie). Samples were sourced from the Petrie and Narangba quarry, and from Boral Lawnton Sand & Gravel.

Boral Petrie Quarry: Greenstone sample (concrete, asphalt and road base) screenings 5mm 10mm 20mm.

Boral Narangba Quarry: Greenstone sample rock, Greenstone sample (concrete, asphalt and road base) screenings 5mm 10mm 20mm; and Hornfels sample rock (high strength concrete) screenings 5mm 10mm 20mm.

Boral Lawnton Sand and Gravel: 5mm, 10mm, 20mm, coarse sand, 70/30 blend
