**Meeting started: 5.00pm**

**1. Apologies:**

See above. Apologies were read out.

**2. Action Items**

- Clayton Hill gave an update on the progress of the Quarry Extension proposal - see heading 3. below.
- Final Fire Management Plan was distributed.
- Andy Stuart was in touch with Garry McCormack, QFRS, and it was established that the fire brigade would cut the lock to the gate on Adsett's Road with bolt cutters in case of an emergency. Therefore QFRS do not require a key to the gate.

**3. Quarry Extension Proposal**

- The application was approved by PRSC and the Decision Notice was issued on 2 October 2007. *Approval had some administration and legal errors, which was corrected by Negotiated Decision approved by Council at the General Council meeting of 4 December 2007. Once the approval is received, it will be reviewed and a determination will be made as to what is required before extraction can commence. The development of management plans and further Operational Works Approvals will take approximately 3-4 months before extraction of the new area specified by the DA can commence.*
- Clayton will provide a list of key action items for the information of the community liaison group members at the next meeting.

- Clayton to announce planting dates for the Petrie fodder plantation within the Powerlink easement to Wanda as soon as possible.

#### 4. **Bushfire Management Plan:**

A copy of the Final Bushfire Management Plan (BMP) for the quarry site was distributed to:

- Bound copies were handed out to Clayton Hill, Andy Stuart, Steve Pyne and Wanda Grabowski.
- One bound copy was posted to Garry McCormack, QFRS on 5 December 2007.
- A copy will be sent via e-mail to Wayne Hardy.
- Greg Dunlop requested a copy of the BMP procedures via e-mail.

During Wayne Hardy's absence, he requested the following information be recorded in the minutes:

- Wayne has asked for the SEQ back-burning schedule, but has not received a response as yet. Wayne will forward the information to Wanda Grabowski and Elke Stapf once at hand.
- Any questions on the SEQ Fire Management Plan can be referred to Wayne directly.

#### 5. **Current Local Issues**

There were no local issues to report at this meeting.

#### 6. **Current Operational Issues**

- Business as usual, nothing to report.

#### 7. **Any other business**

- Petrie Koala Fodder Plantation: Boral obtained a quote to engage Australian Bio-Active Compost Tea to trial a program to improve the soil and foliage of existing fodder plantation. Half a row of the fodder trees will receive folia spray and soil drench. This program is planned for Dec 2007 and January 2008. Elke is to report on progress to Wanda Grabowski on a regular basis.
- Wanda said the leaf cutters reported the fodder of the Petrie Koala Fodder plantation was rejected by the koalas of the Australia Zoo hospital. Wanda believes the poor quality of the soil affects the leaf and hence has little nutrition.
- Wanda announced that Anika & Henk Lehman have joined KAPRI. Anika & Henk will need to contact Andy Stuart for a site induction before being able to visit the site to collect koala fodder from our fodder plantation. As they are part of KAPRI, there is no need to sign a new agreement.
- Narangba Koala Fodder Plantation: the contract for the proposed Narangba fodder plantation is with the Australia Zoo to be signed.
- Clayton announced his promotion to a new role "Northside Quarry Area Manager" for SEQ Quarries. Clayton will replace Bruce Barry, who will be the new "Southside Quarry Area Manager" for SEQ Quarries.
- The Issue 8 Boral 'Changing Perceptions' newsletter was distributed to the members.
