- Provide a plan or perspective map displaying the stages and views from the southeast corner of the quarry:
 - Tim Slack displayed a the final pit design of the quarry
- Update on Quarry Extension Implementation
 - Pre-start conditions have been satisfied, and work has commenced within the approved extension area
 - Quarrying operations on remainder of site will remain the same
 - A controlled burn will take place on site in the coming months. Firebreaks have been put in place on the site in order to control the burn and provide access for the Rural Fire Brigade. It will be a 'cool burn' carried out in the afternoon/evening one or two weekends - depending on the size of the team and availability of rural fire brigade. Neighbours will be notified a day before the burn.
 - On completion of the burn, landscape rehabilitation works in the buffer lands will commence.
