- Boral royal reds decking is a mix of Dura 1 red Australian hardwood species, giving it a colour comparable to the red clay deserts of the Australian outback.
- A hardwood timber deck provides a way to enhance any home, garden, commercial or retail property. A hardwood timber deck creates a comfortable, attractive and flexible feature.
- Australian hardwood species are naturally grown and sourced in Australia making them perfect for any Australian venue and the Australian climate.
- Royal reds decking is naturally termite and fire resistant and suitable for use in BAL 19 areas under Australian Standard AS 3959.
- Royal reds can be used for internal flooring and outdoor decking, to provide a seamless transition from inside to outside, expanding living areas or to create an outdoor room.
- Australian hardwoods can easily be finished with a clear decking oil or stain. Alternatively, the timber can be left to weather. After timber has weathered it can be restored to its original colour by resanding and coating.
- Boral Timber royal reds decking is Responsible Wood Chain of Custody certified providing peace of mind that Boral's decking is sourced from sustainably managed and legal forestry.
